It will be another great opportunity for interested buyers to meet with Realtors®, Lenders and Homebuyer counselors all in one location.

At the Housing Fair attendees have One Stop Access to the following:

- Boston property listings including REO listings from local Realtors®
- Opportunity to meet with our participating lenders and learn about specialty mortgage products
- Information on money available for qualified buyers purchasing REO properties
- Purchase/Rehab money for qualified REO purchases
- Cash to close – downpayment and closing cost assistance for qualified first time homebuyer purchasers
- Homebuying 101 courses and seminars on purchasing a foreclosed property or a home needing repairs
- Affordable housing opportunities available on a First Come First Serve Basis

Realtor® Criteria for City of Boston Housing Fairs

On September 26, 2009 the City of Boston will host another Housing Fair to match homebuyers to REO properties listed for sale in Boston. The fair will include Realtors®, Participating Lenders, Non Profit Counselors, as well as city employees who will cover various programs and services.

While we would like to invite as many Realtors® as possible, we are limited by the size of the venue and therefore have to limit the number of participants. As a result, Realtors® will be chosen to participate in the homebuyer fairs based upon the following qualifications:

- Number of REO listings in Boston, particularly in high foreclosure neighborhoods such as Dorchester, Mattapan, Hyde Park and East Boston.
- Number of recent REO sales in Boston with a preference for sales in high foreclosure neighborhoods
- Number of short sales in Boston, particularly in Dorchester, Mattapan, Hyde Park and East Boston.
- Number of sales to first time homebuyers and/or owner occupant buyers
- Experience working with REO listings
- Number of listings in Boston
- Preference for Realtors® who have a minimum of 5+ REO listings and at least 3 REO sales within the past 3-6 months
- Willingness to adhere to the Department of Neighborhood Development's Realtors® Memorandum of Understanding (see attached)
- Preference will be given to Realtors® with local offices in Boston and those who participated in previous Housing Fairs

Realtor Memorandum of Understanding

As a participant in the City of Boston's Homebuyer Fair, I/We agree to adhere to the following terms:

- I/We agree to participate in the City of Boston's Department of Neighborhood Development scheduled Homebuyer Fairs
- I/We agree to only bring REO and/or Short Sales listings to the Homebuyer Fairs
- I/We agree not to require exclusive buyer broker contracts with participants met through Homebuyer Fairs
- I/We agree to inform eligible buyers about the City of Boston's Department of Neighborhood Development financial assistance programs, educational resources and list of participating lenders
- I/We agree not to steer buyers to particular lenders, mortgage brokers, home inspectors; and attorneys
- I/We agree to provide to DND all of our Boston REO and Short Sale listings five days prior to the Homebuyer Fair
- I/We agree to schedule open houses on some of our REO listings the weekend of the Homebuyer Fair
- I/We agree to provide follow-up information on REO purchases as requested by DND
