

The Greater Boston Association of Realtors'® (GBAR) Diversity Scholarships provide training and financial support to members of underrepresented racial groups who aspire to a career in real estate.

Through this program, GBAR will provide scholarship recipients with:

- Tuition costs to attend a real estate salesperson pre-licensing course offered in partnership with the New England Real Estate Academy*;
- Reimbursement of the registration fee to take the salesperson's licensing exam up to two times;
- Free local, state and national dues for the first year of membership in the Realtor[®] organization, if affiliated with a Realtor[®] member firm of the Greater Boston Real Estate Board.

To be eligible for a scholarship, individuals must meet several criteria. Specifically, applicants must be:

- At least 18 years of age;
- A legal U.S. resident and permanent resident of Massachusetts;
- Residing in one of 64 communities in the Greater Boston Real Estate Board/GBAR jurisdiction (see opposite side for jurisdictional map and list of communities);
- A member of a racial minority (defined as a person of race or national origin that is African American, Asian American/Pacific Islander, Hispanic/Latino, Middle Eastern American, Native American:
- Able to satisfy the requirements for licensure for real estate salespersons set by the Massachusetts Board of Registration of Real Estate Brokers & Salespersons,
- Scholarship recipients will have three months from notification of selection to enroll in the salesperson pre-licensing course and six months from the date of enrollment to complete the course.
- *New England Real Estate Academy courses, are offered on weekdays, weeknights and weekends, and include 20 hours of online training via webinar; 20 hours of self-directed study; digital and audio versions of the "Principles of Real Estate Practice in Massachusetts" instruction manual; and access to a monthly study group, quizzes and a practice final exam.
